Biodiversity instructions

Western Caspian University (WCU) invites not only its students, university staff members, but also community to make steps in sustainable management of biodiversity in different areas. The purpose of this instruction is to increase activities in order to maintain standard of biodiversity safeguard and enhancement.

- 1. Increase awareness about the sustainable use of biodiversity within and beyond the university
- 2. Decrease the pressure in forestry and fishing activities
- 3. Work on research and/or development projects based on preserving flora and fauna
- 4. Develop modern biotechnological methods
- 5. Create green corridors in order to support wildlife in land
- 6. Save as much the aquatic Biosystems as possible
- 7. Build nest boxes for birds
- 8. Use fauna friendly lighting
- 9. Engage actively in tree-planting action
- 10. Try to eliminate personal activities done for pleasure, such as hunting
- 11. Do not hunt any kind of animals during closed seasons
- 12. Take extreme care of animals and plants who are in the red list (Azerbaijan's Red Book)

One of the main goals of the university is to ensure the integration of biodiversity in order to create well-being for students, staff, and visitors. Caspian Sea Problems Research Center conducts basic research and applied scientific research focused on gaining new knowledge of biology and ecology of the Caspian Sea and inland waters.
