#### Discussion:

Analysis of the Fall Semester Examination Results for the 2024–2025 Academic Year of the School of Design

Deputy Dean *Leyla Efendiyeva* reported that a total of **161 students** from the School of Design participated in the final examinations across **12 major subject areas** during the Fall semester of the 2024–2025 academic year. The overall results are as follows:

- **Overall success rate:** 94%
- **Overall quality rate:** 78%

**Average success rate:** 93.1%

**Average quality rate:** 67.1%

These results demonstrate that the overall teaching and assessment processes in the faculty are effectively organized. However, due to low quality scores in certain subjects, it was determined that additional support measures are required.

### Observations and Recommendations:

- Examination outcomes indicate overall strong academic performance.
- The highest results were observed in *Photo Design* and *Painting* courses.
- Lower performance was recorded in *Decorative Coating Materials* and *History and Methodology of Design Art*.
- It was proposed that **supplementary support classes** be organized for subjects with weaker results.
