III. EXAMINATION METHODS:

1. Consultation hours are organized before the exam.
2. Exams and intermediate assessments (colloquiums) are conducted in written form.

3. The issues regarding students' eligibility for exams and intermediate assessments are solved by the faculty dean. Exams and intermediate assessments are conducted following the "Regulations on Organizing the Credit System of Teaching at Higher Education Institutions in Azerbaijan" approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan on December 24, 2013, No. 348.
4. Students are provided with topics for their term paper and relevant literature in advance. A commission established by the department accepts the term paper defense.
5. Each student must complete 1 individual work during the semester. The topics of individual works cover the materials covered in the course. Each individual work is graded on a 10-point scale, and the final grade is the arithmetic average of all individual works.

IV. GENERAL RULES:

1. ATTENDANCE: A student who misses more than 25% of the total class hours is not allowed to take the exam.

2. SUBJECT MASTERING RULES:

Maximum points: 100 points

1. Maximum points during the semester: 50 points

-Attendance: Maximum 10 points

-Individual work: Maximum 10 points

-Seminar activity: Maximum 30 points

If a student has at least 3 marks in the register, points are counted for this part of the course. Otherwise, no points are awarded.

2. Exam result: Maximum 50 points

The minimum required points for passing the exam: 17 points.

3. A student who gets more than 50 points from both the semester and the exam is considered to have passed the course.
