
General Results:

Students expressed their opinions on various aspects of the exams. The results are summarized as follows:

Was the exam duration sufficient for you?	257	49	67

Student Feedback:

The open-ended responses from students in the survey were categorized into several key areas:

1. Exam Organization and Timing:

- Students expressed significant dissatisfaction with the short intervals between exams.
- It was suggested that exams for distance learning students should be scheduled in alignment with the academic term.

2. Delayed Result Announcements:

• Many students highlighted that exam results were announced very late, negatively affecting their preparation for subsequent exams.

3. Difficulty and Transparency of Questions:

- Complaints were raised about the large number of questions and that some exams included questions from topics not covered in class.
- Transitioning to a test-based format was noted as more transparent and objective, especially in the Mechanics and Mathematics departments.

4. Behavior of Teachers and Invigilators:

- The rude behavior of invigilators increases student stress.
- Some students reported unfair grading practices by teachers in certain cases.


5. Quality of Teaching Materials:

• Some students felt that the teaching materials provided were insufficient for adequate exam preparation.




1. Performance of Students by Faculty (Dean's Office) in the Survey.

1. Indicators of students participating in the survey by courses.




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2. Indicators of students participating in the survey by form of education.






3. Indicators of Students Participating in the Survey by Language of Instruction.
