

On determining the norms of teaching load of pedagogical staff of educational institutions

RESOLUTION OF THE CABINET OF MINISTERS OF THE REPUBLIC OF AZERBAIJAN

In order to ensure the implementation of paragraph 1.24 of the Decree of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated September 5, 2009 No. 156 "On the implementation of the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan "On Education", the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan decides:

1. The teaching load norms for pedagogical staff of educational institutions should be determined as follows:

weekly working hours of educators in preschool educational institutions - 30 hours;

in all types of general education schools, gymnasiums and lyceums, and vocational education institutions, the teaching load of teachers in 1 (one) shift is 18 hours (in this case, the weekly teaching load should not exceed 2 (two) shifts), in sports and art schools, and in out-of-school educational institutions, the teaching load of teachers in 1 (one) shift is 12 hours (in this case, the weekly teaching load should not exceed 3 (three) shifts);

weekly working hours of educators-teachers in general education schools, boarding schools, lyceums, gymnasiums and vocational schools - 24 hours;

the annual teaching load of professors and concertmasters at higher and secondary specialized educational institutions on a single salary basis - not less than 500 hours (at this time, the amount of time allocated to lectures, seminars, laboratory and practical classes in higher educational institutions, as well as individual lessons in specialties with a cultural, musical, and artistic orientation, should not be less than 60 percent of the annual teaching load, and the amount of time allocated to theoretical, laboratory and practical classes in secondary specialized educational institutions, as well as individual lessons in specialties with a cultural, musical, and artistic orientation, should not be less than 80 percent of the annual teaching load).

2. This decision shall enter into force on the date of its signing.
